Annual Programme - Journey 15

Annual cultural programme - Journey 15 was organized by the school which was attended by eminent personalities of the city and parents.

Journey 15 (Part I) was presented by the students of Classes 6 to 12 on 16th December 2017. The Chief Guest, Mr. Antarip Sood, Superintendent of Police Rajkot Rural, inaugurated the programme by lighting the lamp and releasing balloons. Head boys and Head girls presented the school report. Three alumni of the school were felicitated by the Chief Guest. Pro Vice Chairman Mr. Rajendra Kamdar, Col. Salil Baxi from NCC Rajkot, Mr. Sudhanshu Nayak, Principal, Podar International School Rajkot, Members of the School Managing Committee graced the occasion. While sharing their experiences, the alumni thanked the school for its role in building their careers and personalities.
















Best Instrumentalist of the School Competition

Skating Championship


Shamik Bhadaliya of Class 2 secured second position in Fifth Open Saurashtra Skating Championship in Short and Long races.
