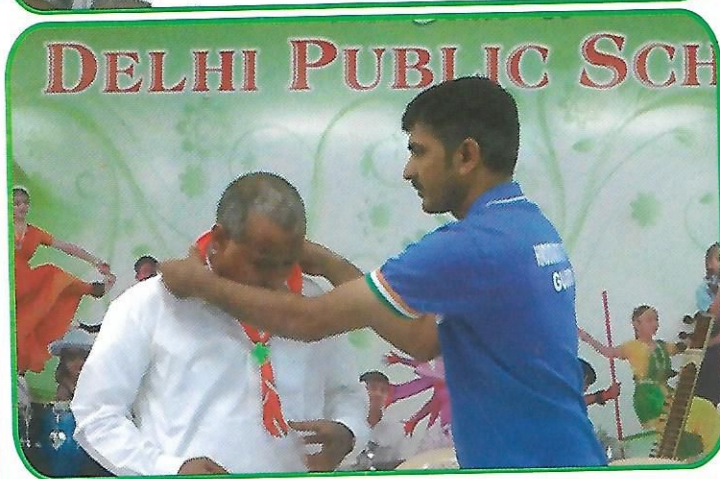
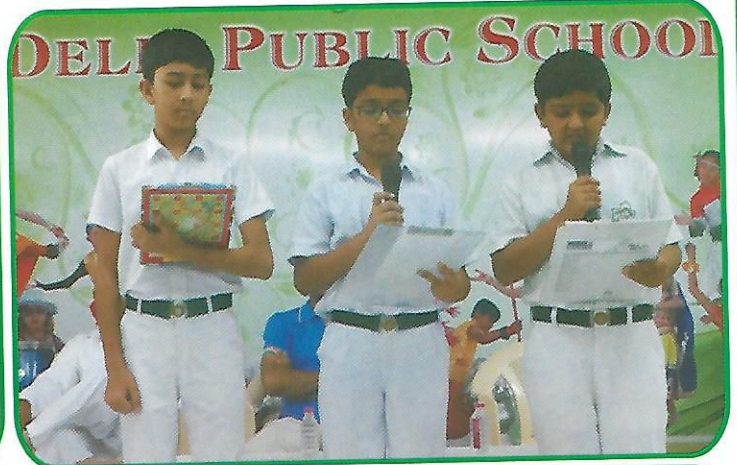
Felicitation of toppers and students with 100% attendance

Class 5-Chinese goods vs Indian goods

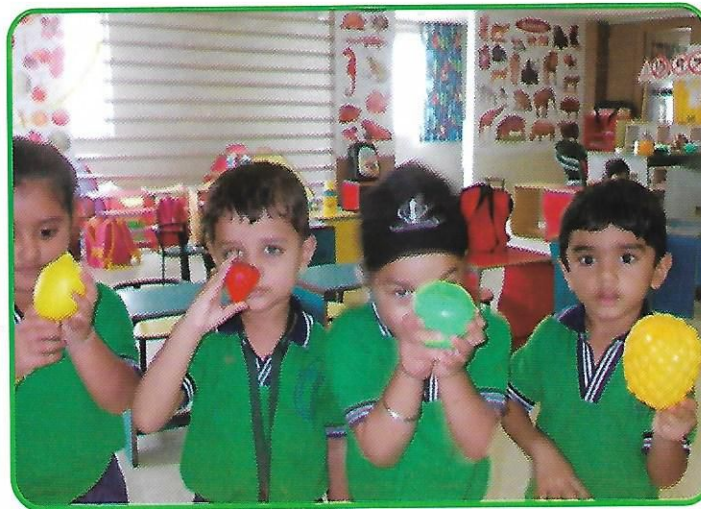
Yellow Day

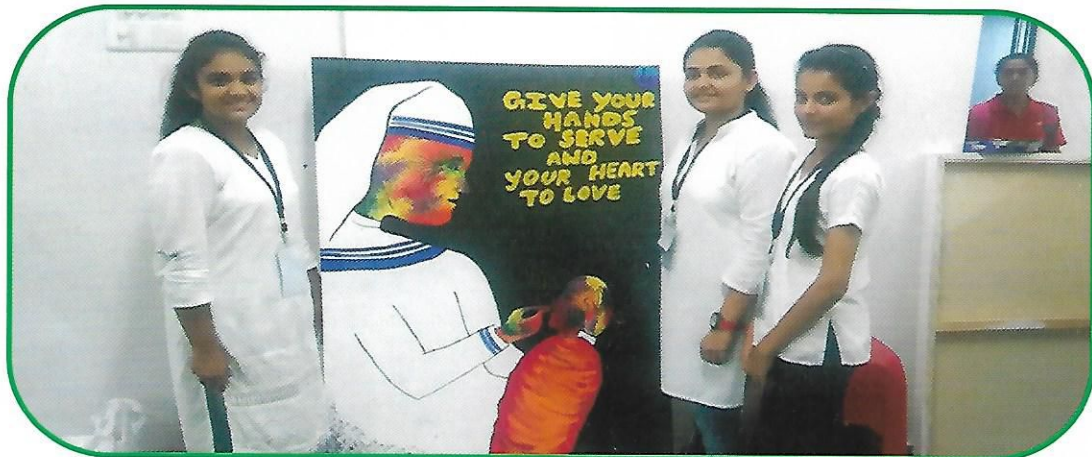
» Badminton
