DPS Rajkot reaches villages through Cycle Rally









"India lives in its villages" said Mahatma Gandhi. Therefore, the change we want to see in our country must begin at the grass root level i.e. in our villages. The students and staff of the school decided to reach the villages and organized a cycle rally on 14th September 2013. They covered three nearby villages of Ishwariya, Haripar and Munjka with the objective of spreading in the villages the noble messages i) Grow more trees ii) Stop using poly bags and iii) Save fuel. The rally was flagged off from the school by the Senior and Junior Head Girls Riddhima Shrivastava and Kuhuk Patnaik respectively. Parent Representatives Ms. Moumita Nag and Mr. Richard Nag also joined the rally which was led by Principal, Mr. Manoj Dubey.

Even the cloudy day and impending rains could not deter the enthusiasm of the Dipsites as three teams of students, staff and parents reached the villages on their bicycles. The students interacted with the Sarpanchs and other members of the villages and gave them plant saplings. They explained to them the importance of saving fossil fuel and harmful effects of using poly bags and distributed non poly bags in the villages. The students also gave banners with the school's message to the Sarpanchs to be displayed in the villages.
