Hand art activities were conducted for Class Prep. in the month of April 2015.

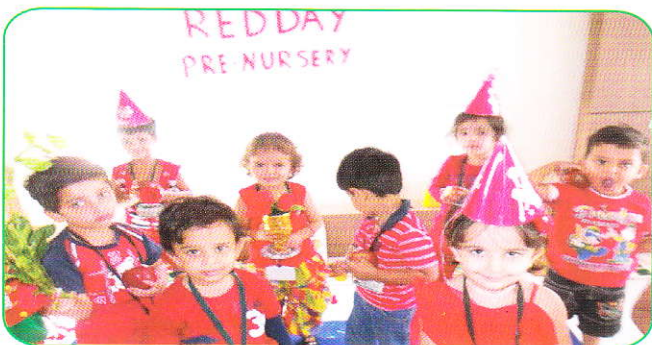
### Hand Wash Activity

### Red Day

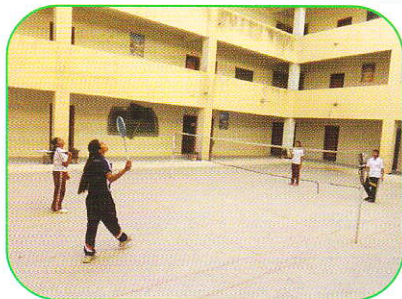
The students of Classes Pre. Nursery had Red Day on 23th April 2015. The students came dressed in red and enjoyed learning about the concept of red colour.
