3. Activities - Pre-Nursery:

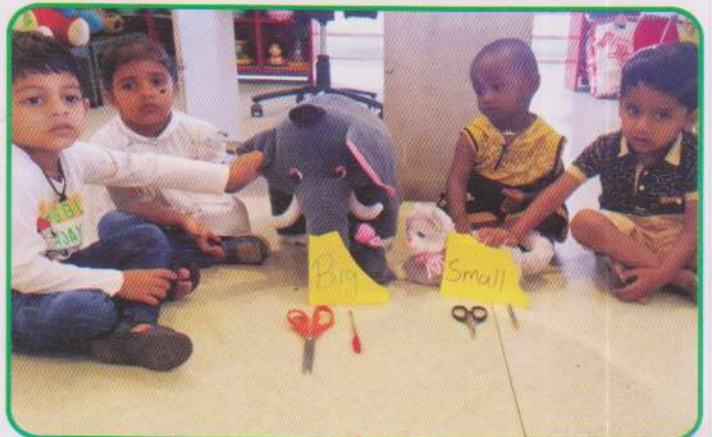
